



September School Fundraiser Program

WHAT WE'RE DOING:

During the month of September, Grand Central Bowl will partner with participating area schools to raise money for their organization by dining at Grand Central Bowl. Schools are encouraged to promote to the parents the opportunity to raise money for their child's school by dining at Grand Central Bowl. When dining at Grand Central Bowl, 15% of guests' check will be donated to the participating school Parent Teacher Association (PTA).

Guests simply mention, to their server, the name of the participating school they wish their contribution to be given to and at the end of September Grand Central Bowl will tally up the sales and donate 15% of their tab to the schools PTA.

WHEN:

September 1 - 30. Only applicable Monday through Thursday.

HOW SCHOOLS REGISTER TO PARTICIPATE:

Area elementary, middle & high schools who would like to participate can sign up by emailing cegportland@gmail.com.

Deadline for registering is August 24, 2022. ONLY the first 10 schools, per location, to RSVP will be eligible. Required is; PTO/PTA physical business address, main contact and copy of their 501(c)(3) documentation.

SALES PERCENTAGE:

Organizations receive credit for dine-in purchases only. 15% rebate is based on pre-tax prices excluding gratuity, retail and gift cards.

HOW GUESTS RECEIVE CREDIT:

Guests are required to present an official flier or mention the school that they are supporting to their server in order to receive credit. Flyers shown digitally or print will be accepted.

FUNDRAISING FLIER:

A customized flier in PDF & JPeg format will be supplied to the schools to print and distribute to their parents.

WHEN AND HOW DONATION CHECKS ARE CALCULATED:

Donation checks will be paid to the PTO/PTA for those schools raising a minimum of \$100 or more through guest's contributions. Tallies will be done **Wednesday, October 5th** and checks distributed by the following week.

HOW IT WORKS AT THE RESTAURANT:

Organizations who have received confirmation of participation will be on the Grand Central Bowl list of approved schools in their area. Only 10 schools per location will be eligible. A list of participating schools will be supplied to the respective Grand Central Bowl management teams with detailed instructions.
